RESPECTFUL BEHAVIOR

OVER THE YEARS PRACTICAL GUIDELINES OF GOOD SENSE AND COURTEOUS BEHAVIOR HAVE EMERGED WHICH ENCOURAGE AND ALLOW EVERYONE TO HAVE A NICE DAY AT ALL NUDIST/NATURIST EVENTS.

SO THAT EVERYONE CAN HAVE A MOST ENJOYABLE TIME, PLEASE RESPECT AND PRACTICE THE FOLLOWING STANDARDS.

- Nudism/naturism is healthy both physically and mentally. Lewd behavior, and sexual behavior demonstrates disrespect of others in the group. It undermines our image and will not be tolerated.
- Respect the property of others.
- Please shower with soap before using pools or hot tubs.
- Prior consent for photography must be obtained from ALL individuals who are photographed or are possible background subjects of the photograph. Parents permission MUST be obtained before children are photographed.
- Detectable drunkenness will not be tolerated. Drunken behavior in a group demonstrates disrespect of others.
- Drugs, controlled, and illegal substances are prohibited.
- Please, no smoking within an inclosed air space. Outside is fine.
- When sitting on a chair or bench please sit on a towel.
- Please do not bring glass containers to a pool, sauna, or hot tub area or anyplace where accidental breakage could create a hazard.
- Clean up after yourself. Leave the area as clean, or cleaner than you found it.
- Discrimination of any kind will not be tolerated.
- It is not wrong for a man and woman to make new friends - but it is rude to monopolize a person's time when the welcome mat was never put out.
- Speak up for nudist/naturist standards. If you see a person who seems unaware of the standards, please explain them, kindly and plainly.

BE AWARE THAT IN SWIMMING AREAS LIFEGUARDS WILL NOT BE ON DUTY. Be careful and be responsible.
